Finding God and discovering my spiritual gifts. I was raised outside of church culture, and for a time outside of America. This gave me experience with multiple cultures and religions. During my first semester of college a classmate shared the Gospel with me. God convinced me the Gospel is real and the Bible is His written Word. I confessed my sins and prayed to accept Jesus as my Lord and Savior. My journey has been long and difficult at times. I would not trade any step of my walk with God because everything He has allowed, or caused to happen in my life, has eventually resulted in my being used to help others fall in love with Him. I have no greater joy than knowing my spiritual gifts help other Christians to use their spiritual gifts.

Throughout twenty seven years of active Christian service, sometimes as a volunteer, there has been ample demonstration of the gifts God gave to me. But something more was needed if I was going to become effective at reaching people.

Eventually, God spoke to me and my wife during our individual prayer times. We believed it was God giving us the message because we heard it separately from each other, and it was consistent. God said it was time for me to go to seminary. I will never be able to praise my professors and classmates enough. I was routinely challenged to defend every theological position, state my cases in plain English (not engineer-speak) and be prepared to give a defense of the Gospel in every situation.

Shortly after I finished seminary God gave us two wonderful sons by way of adoption. William and James are amazing guys. That same year I met Pastor Juan Ramirez in a miraculous way and I was his Associate Pastor until his death in 2014.

During and after seminary the Lord has used my international upbringing and cross-cultural experiences to have me preach, teach and disciple people from various cultures and ethnicities. I am best suited for a ministry that celebrates the power of God to make joyful disciples of all who will come to Him.
